




2014 Nevada Area Council's National Youth Leadership Training



June 16-21, 2014

Camp Fleischmann – Chester, CA

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is an exciting, action-packed program designed for Councils to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home Troops, Teams, or Crews and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must *BE*, what he/she must *KNOW*, and what he/she must *DO*. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on *HOW TO*. The skills come alive during the week as the teams go on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.

NYLT is a six-day course. Content is delivered in group and team outdoor settings with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids which allows participants to understand and employ the leadership skills much faster.

Participants must:

- Be at least 13 years old (Venturers must be 14 years old) as of the start of the course.
- Be at least First Class in rank (Venturers must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews (ILSC) or Venturing Leadership Skills Course (VLSC) as of the start of the course.
- Have Scoutmaster/Coach/Crew Advisor approval.
- Be willing to behave in accordance with the Scout Oath and Scout Law at NYLT.
- *Be Prepared* mentally, emotionally, and physically to handle a week of NYLT.
- Arrive at 9 AM on Day 1 wearing full Scouting Uniform or BSA Venturing Uniform and be in attendance for the entire course ending at noon on Day 6.

Participants should:

- Be a “credit” to their unit—dedicated, conscientious, and responsible.
- Be serving in, or about to serve in, a significant Troop, Team, or Crew leadership role.
- Have good basic camping and outdoor skills.
- Want to attend.

- **Course Fee: \$290** (*Early bird discount cost is \$250 if paid in full by Wednesday, April 15, 2014.*)
—Course fee includes all meals, instructional materials, and all recognition materials.
- **Registration and Deposit**
—Every participant must complete the two-page registration form.
—A \$100 deposit is due with your registration for the course. This deposit is non-refundable, but transferrable.
—These two items will secure your spot on the 2014 NYLT Course roster.
- **Full payment must be received no later than May 15, 2014.**
—Payment may be made either by cash, check, or credit card to the NAC Service Center or Elko BSA Field Office.
- Every participant must submit a completed BSA Annual Health and Medical Record #680-001 (*parts A, B, and C*) no later than May 15, 2014 (*can download at <http://www.scouting.org>*).




